



Prince Edward Island 2008 Lieutenant Governor's Award of Excellence in Architecture

The Architects' Association of Prince Edward Island is very pleased to announce the inaugural Lieutenant Governor's Award of Excellence in Architecture. AAPEI extends this invitation to all of its registered members and ask that they submit entries.

Preamble

In 2007, AAPEI Council proposed the idea of a Lieutenant Governor's Award for Excellence in Architecture for Island Architects. The concept was then tabled and endorsed by the participants at AAPEI's 2007 Annual General Meeting.

The Honourable Barbara A. Hagerman, Lieutenant Governor of Prince Edward Island, has enthusiastically endorsed this initiative and is pleased to host the award ceremony at Government House on Thursday, June 5, 2008. This award program will provide an opportunity to recognize outstanding design work by Prince Edward Island Architects. It will be instituted and administered by the AAPEI and offered biannually. A jury will assess the entries and all entries will be exhibited in a public forum.

Please take some time to review your recent work and give consideration for submissions. This is an opportunity to draw attention to the distinctive architectural heritage of Prince Edward Island.

Objective

The objective of the Lieutenant Governor's Award of Excellence in Architecture is to recognize and celebrate outstanding architectural design accomplishments in completed projects by Prince Edward Island Architects.

Eligibility

Any project (including off-Island projects) where the Architect of Record is an Island Architect, i.e. lives and practices in PEI, are eligible. Any work that has achieved substantial performance by April 30, 2008 is eligible for consideration for the 2008 awards. This work can include new construction, renovation restoration, and additions to existing buildings. There are no restrictions on project size or location, i.e. urban, rural or suburban. Architects may enter as many submissions as they wish. A project may only be submitted once for

consideration and subsequently will not be eligible for submission for future awards. Each submission requires completion of the Intent to Submit Form.

Jury

The jury will be comprised of three individuals from the architectural/design/arts community. Jury members are to be confirmed. Prior to being judged, all submissions will be prescreened to ensure they meet the eligibility requirements. The decision of the jury will be final.

Awards/Categories

The jury will be instructed to judge each entry based on its own merits and will not be ranked against each other according to building type/size etc. There will be one award given, however the jury may recommend one or more submissions as honorable mentions. The jury may also recommend that no awards are given.

Exhibition

Entries are submitted with the understanding that images will be displayed on the AAPEI website and that submissions will be exhibited in a public forum. The submissions will remain property of the architect or firm. Winning submissions will also be featured in the media.

Format

All entries should be mounted on A1 (24x36) foam core (12.5mm thick material) which is suitable to hang in a gallery space with a maximum 3 boards per entry. Digital submissions are required, for the website, and should be sent in the form of a hard-copy DVD to:

If you have more than one submission, please put them in different folders on the DVD. Please include “**Architects’ Awards 2008**” on the DVD and Case. The Project Summary Sheet must be completed and included with each entry. AAPEI will not be responsible for damage or loss of submissions.

Entry Fee

An entry fee of \$100 must accompany each submission. Cheques should be made payable to the Architects’ Association of Prince Edward Island.

Deadlines

The Intention to Submit form must be received by 5 pm AST on April 4, 2008. Mail to: AAPEI, PO Box 1766, Charlottetown PE, C1A 7N4. Formal submissions, including payment, deadline is Thursday, May 15, 2008. Delivery time and location for entries will be announced.
